## **FESTIVAL INFORMATION**

19 – 22 JULY 2019

**Konzert Pte Ltd** proudly presents the **9<sup>th</sup> A VOYAGE OF SONGS**, International Choral Festival, to be held on 19<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 in Bangkok, Thailand.

This festival was first held in Genting Highlands (Malaysia) in 2003, Shah Alam (Malaysia) in 2005, Pattaya (Thailand) in 2007, Penang (Malaysia) in 2009, Zhuhai (China) in 2011, Bangkok (Thailand) in 2013, Penang (Malaysia) in 2015 and Taoyuan (Taiwan) in 2017. All 8 festivals took place successfully with more than 7000 participants from all over the world gathering to compete in one of the premier choral festival in Asia-Pacific.

The objective of the festival is to promote greater appreciation of choral music, especially in the Asia-Pacific region, through an exchange of music and culture between choristers from different countries and the various judges. This would strengthen the choral movement in the region and establish friendships among the participants.

To celebrate its success for being one of Asia-Pacific's premier choral festival, the Grand Prize winner of the **9<sup>th</sup> A VOYAGE OF SONGS** will receive a special cash prize of **SGD \$5, 000** and a Conductor Prize of **SGD \$1, 000**

**Bangkok** is the capital city of Thailand. Usually known in its short name in Thai as **Krung Thep** meaning "city of angels", the full name however is called

*"Krung thep mahanakhon amorn ratanakosin mabintharayutthaya mabadilok popnoparat ratchathani burirom udomratchanivetmabasathan amornpiman avatarnsathit sakkehattiyavisnukarmprasit"*

An English rendering goes like this:

*"The city of angels, the great city, the residence of the Emerald Buddha, the impregnable city of Ayutthaya of God Indra, the grand capital of the world endowed with nine precious gems, the happy city, abounding in an enormous Royal Palace that resembles the heavenly abode where reigns the reincarnated god, a city given by Indra and built by Vishnukarn".*

And it is listed as the world's longest location name by the Guinness Book of Records.



Considered to be one of the world's tourist hotspots, Bangkok is Thailand's major tourist gateway. The city boasts some of the country's most visited historical venues such as the Grand Palace, Wat Pho and Wat Arun.

# FESTIVAL HIGHLIGHTS

## Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony of **A VOYAGE OF SONGS 2019** will comprise of the assembly of all participating choirs, adjudicators and the official opening concert by choirs specially chosen by the festival office.

## Friendship Concert

Participating choirs can request to participate in the Friendship Concert, which will be held on the evening of 20<sup>th</sup> July. Each performing choir shall present a 10 minute programme.

## Choral Masterclass

Choral Masterclass will be presented by selected Adjudicators for all participants, which will be held on 21<sup>st</sup> July morning of the festival. More information will be provided later.

## Choir Evaluation with Adjudicators

Choirs and their conductor will have the opportunity to receive exclusive feedback from the adjudicators. They will evaluate with each participating choir on their performance during the competition.

## Award Presentation Ceremony

After the competition, the awards and diplomas will be presented in the course of a ceremony to take place in a festival atmosphere in the convention hall. The category winners will be honoured in an award presentation ceremony with festival fanfare.

## Grand Prize Concert

After all categories of competition have ended, the category winners will present their winning choral pieces to all participants and visitors in a Grand Prize Concert. The winner of the concert will be chosen and the festival's Grand Prize will be awarded.

## Closing Ceremony

The closing ceremony of **A VOYAGE OF SONGS** will take place on the 21<sup>th</sup> of July 2019. The winners for Grand Prize, Conductor Prize and the Special Jury Awards will also be announced.



# INTERNATIONAL CHORAL COMPETITION

## Competition Categories

### A, Mixed Choir (SATB)

- A1, Open Category (No Age Limit)
- A2, Senior Youth Category (For ages 19 and below)
- A3, Junior Youth Category (For ages 16 and below)

### B, Equal Voices Choir (SA or TB)

- B1, Open Category SA Chorus (No Age Limit)
- B2, Open Category TB Chorus (No Age Limit)
- B3, Senior Youth Category (For ages 19 and below)
- B4, Junior Youth Category (For ages 16 and below)

#### Rules and Guidelines for all Categories of A/B:

1. One *original choral composition/arrangement* from choir's home country or its cultural region;
2. One *original composition/arrangement* **NOT** from choir's home country or its cultural region;
3. One freely chosen choral piece.
4. Minimum 1 song to be sung *a capella*.
5. The total singing time for 3 songs *must not* exceed **15** minutes for **Open Category** (A1, B1 & B2) and **12** minutes for **Youth category** (A2, A3, B3 & B4).
6. There should be a minimum of **16** singers in the choir *excluding* conductor *and/or* accompanists.

### C, Children's Choir (For ages 12 and below)

#### Rules and Guidelines for Category C:

1. One *original choral composition/arrangement* from choir's home country or its cultural region;
2. One *original choral composition/arrangement* **NOT** from choir's home country or its cultural region;
3. The total singing time for both songs *must not* exceed **8** minutes.
4. There should be a minimum of **16** singers in the choir *excluding* conductor *and/or* accompanists.

### D, Chamber Choir (No age limit)

#### Rules and Guidelines for Category D:

1. One *original choral composition/arrangement* from choir's home country or its cultural region;
2. One *original composition/arrangement* **NOT** from choir's home country or its cultural region;
3. One freely chosen choral piece.
4. Minimum 1 song to be sung *a capella*.
5. The total singing time for 3 songs *must not* exceed **15** minutes.
6. There should be a minimum of **8** and maximum of **20** singers in the choir *excluding* conductor *and/or* accompanists.

### E, Senior Choir (For ages 50 and above)

#### Rules and Guidelines for Category E:

1. Two freely chosen choral pieces
2. The total singing time for both songs *must not* exceed **8** minutes.

## F, Folklore (No age limit)

### Rules and Guidelines for Category F:

1. Two choral arrangements of folk songs from choir's home country or its cultural region should be sung. National costumes are welcomed.
2. The total singing time for both songs *must not* exceed **8** minutes.

## S, Sacred Music (No age limit)

### Rules and Guidelines for Category S:

1. One *original choral composition by a composer born before 1900*
2. One *original choral composition by a composer born after 1900*
3. One freely chosen sacred choral piece.
4. Minimum 1 song to be sung *a capella*.
5. The total singing time for 3 songs *must not* exceed **15** minutes
6. There should be a minimum of **16** singers in the choir *excluding* conductor *and/or* accompanists.

### General Competition Rules and Regulations for All Categories

1. Choirs competing in categories with age limits must strictly adhere to them. In case of doubt the organisers reserve the right to check the age of singers.
2. Competition pieces are **NOT** to be repeated between categories, but are allowed for Grand Finals.
3. All competition pieces are to be approved by the artistic committee.
4. Only live accompaniments are allowed. The use of any kind of playback or soundtrack is **strictly prohibited**.
5. Original compositions by composers born in the 20<sup>th</sup> century are to be performed in the original key except if the composer has given a written instruction concerning keys.
6. Choirs that wish to sing in the transposed keys for the earlier works are to inform the festival office in advance and indicate on the scores submitted.
7. Singing time during the competition is to be strictly observed. Choirs that exceed singing time will be penalised. For every 15 seconds exceeded, 5% of the total points will be deducted.
8. For every competition piece, choirs need to submit **5** original copies of the score to the organiser, of which one copy will be kept in the festival archive after the competition. Photocopied scores of published works will not be accepted.
9. Unauthorised audio/visual recording during competitions and concerts is strictly prohibited.
10. No acoustic checks are allowed prior to the competition.
11. Decisions of the adjudicators are final and cannot be contested.

## JUDGING AND EVALUATION

### Criteria for evaluation:

1. Intonation and Chording
2. Tone Quality and Vocal Production
3. Interpretation and Expression
4. Programme Literature and Execution
5. Overall Artistic Impression

Note: If an actual performance exceeds the limit of allocated performance time as set for the category, 5% of the total score of the choir will be deducted for every 15 seconds exceeded.

### Adjudication:

A panel of internationally renowned adjudicators of various nationalities will evaluate the competition. All decisions of the jury are final and cannot be contested.



# AWARDS

## Awarding system:

According to the average of the total scores given by each jury member, choirs will be given the following diplomas:

## The Grand Prize Competition

All category winners with at least a Gold diploma will have the opportunity to take part in the Grand Prize Competition. The announcement of the finalists will be done at the end of the Masterclass Series.

### Rules and Guidelines for Grand Finals:

1. Two freely selected pieces
2. Must be approved by the artistic committee
3. Total singing time must not exceed 10 minutes

## Awards and Special Prizes

### Category Winners:

In each category the choir that is awarded the Gold Diploma with the highest score will be the category winner and will receive a trophy and certificate as category prize.

### Chanson de Voyager

Certificate and Trophy awarded to the choir with the highest scoring piece of the entire competition.

### Special Jury Awards:

The jury may hand out special prizes e.g. Most Promising Choir, Most Promising Conductor for outstanding artistic achievements.

### Conductor's Prize:

The conductor with the most outstanding performance may be awarded a prize and SGD \$1, 000.

### Grand Prize Winner:

The winner of the Grand Prize Competition (refer to below) will receive the special Grand Prize Trophy and SGD \$5, 000.

For the first category that the choir competes in, registration fees for the choir are at **SGD 400**. For every additional category the choir competes in, registration fees are at **SGD 250** per category registered.

All choirs that register before **31<sup>st</sup> March 2019** will enjoy **50%** wavier of all registration categories with **Full Payment of Deposit**.

## 1<sup>st</sup> From Your Country

Registration fee for 1<sup>st</sup> Competition Category is waived for the **1<sup>st</sup> Choir** from each participating country with **Full Payment of Deposit**.

1. Fully completed application form is to be submitted.
2. Fully completed competition programme with the full name of the composers and/or arrangers of each song in sequence of performance.
3. A sound or video recording of the participating choir. The recording should not be older than two years. Choirs can upload the audio/video online (YouTube) and forward the link to us (Please indicate the date of recording).
4. A brief biography / profile of the choir. Max. 120 words.
5. A brief biography of the choral director. Max. 120 words.
6. A softcopy reproducible photo of the choir in landscape format, min.1280 x 960 Pixels or min. 1 MB file size.
7. Clear scanned copy of each competition piece to be submitted with the application form for competition programme approval.

Please submit the following items during choir reporting on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2019

**Five Original Copies** of each competition piece to be submitted on the first day of the festival during choir registration. Original scores are especially required for published works.

*In order to facilitate the preparation and planning of the festival, we kindly request you to send us your fully completed application form as soon as possible. Incomplete or late applications will not be admitted. The festival office reserves the right to refuse applications for artistic or organisational reasons. The application fees will only be refunded if the choir has been rejected.*

*Label all recordings, photographs and other material with your choir's name.*

*Failure to submit all required documents before festival due date, your choir will not be printed on the festival booklet.*
